Now it is hereby agreed as follows:-

1. In order to effectuate the above said desire, the **FOUNDER** has handed over to the **TRUSTEES** a sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Five thousand only) to hold and stand possessed for the same (hereinafter for brevity's sake referred to as Trust Fund) which expression shall also include cash and other property and investments of any kind what so ever in to which the same or any part thereof might be converted, involved or varied from time to time or such may be acquired by the Trustees or come to their hands by virtue of these presents by the operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents upon the trust and with and subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereafter declared and contained of and concerning the same.
2. It is essential that a formal declaration of **TRUST** be made in accordance with the law, now, therefore, the aforesaid **FOUNDER**, do hereby unequivocally declare that a sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Five Thousand only) as specified in Para above do constitute a Trust under the name & style of "**AKHIL BHARATIYA SIKSHA VIKASH TRUST**" and shall have its office at plot no. 126, New Industrial Estate, Jagatpur, Dist- Cuttack/ or at such other place or places as the Trustees may decide from time to time. The said trust property wholly and absolutely set apart for the use and benefit of the public and for charitable object as specified below:

- I. To open, establish, promote, support, run and maintain colleges, schools, and Technical Institutions and Hostels for advancement of general and technical education which includes courses like,
 - a. Engineering and Technology,
 - b. Industrial Tanning centre,
 - c. Medical Science, Pharmacy and Bio Technology,
 - d. Other Technical and vocational courses
- II. To provide job oriented education to unemployed youth in the respective Branches.
- III. To organize workshop, meetings, debates, group discussion or seminars for the development of students and youth in technical line and health.
- IV. To establish libraries, reading rooms, to provide books, news papers, and periodicals.
- V. To provide employment opportunities of the weaker section of the society those living under the poverty lines and to raise their income.
- VI. To give financial assistance to the deserving and needy students, to prosecute higher studies and to award scholarships.
- VII. To get up Orphanage, Old Men's Home, Destitute homes for the relief of the poor Destitutes, Orphans and Widows and to make necessary arrangements for the smooth running of this institution with income of the trust including income from educational institution under its controls and guidance.
- VIII. To bring the awareness in regard to various legal provisions relating to Right to information, labour, women and children.
- IX. To encourage the rural people to raise nurseries, social forestry and tree patts.
- X. To undertake, evaluation work of various welfare, poverty, alienations, economic and other developmental programmes of the state and Central Government.
- XI. And to all such things and to perform all such acts as may be necessary or proper for the achievement of any or all of the above objects.

3. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE TRUST:-

- a) All the activities of the Trust shall be charitable and without any profit motive.
- b) To make necessary construction of buildings for the purpose of said institution, schools, colleges and charitable dispensary or for any other purposes as noted above or can take rooms, houses, buildings on hire basis for the purpose of (with or without the sanction of appropriate authorities) and / or deposit the securities, and pay the initial costs, in

the connection with the appropriate authorities and can purchase or take lease of plots for the said purposes.

- c) The Trust can enhance or raise funds by collecting fees, arranging donations, grants and other contributions from time to time.
- d) The Founder shall also be the one of the trustees during his life and after his death the eldest male member of his family shall be a co-trustee.
- e) If any of the Trustees be a bankrupt or found guilty by the court of an offence involving moral turpitude or become insolvent or remains absent from India for a period of three months or resigns from his post or otherwise incapacitated physically, the remaining trustees with the consent of the Founder so long as she is alive shall appoint her substitute.
- f) In case there is difference of opinion between the Trustees the decision of the majority of the Trustees relating to the Trust shall be binding and be effected and shall be carried out.
- g) In case of failure of the trust for want of its objects or Trust having become impossible or performance, the trustees shall move the court for applying the remaining trust fund for similar objects.
- h) The Trustees shall in no case be liable for any loss to the Trust estate unless the Trustees are guilty of fraud.
- i) This is a public registered Trust. The property of the Trust shall in no case revert to the Founder or his descendents or to any other person.
- j) No part of the trust fund, either the corpus or the income there from, shall be utilize for any object other than that of the Trust hereby created.

4. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS TO OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEE:-

That for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust the Trustees shall have the following powers and shall meet time to time:-

- a) Approval for the plans and the programmes of the Trust and the sanction and allocate funds for the different activities of the Trust.
- b) To constitute committees and sub-committees for the management of institutions, projects and schemes of the Trust.
- c) To appoint office bearers and to supervise their duties and functions.
- d) To accept donations for the general public and to grant proper receipts for the same.
- e) The Trustees shall have the power to borrow money in the security of the trust property alienate the Trust property for necessary purpose.

- f) Out of the income of the Trust be fund the costing defray the expenses for running the same and expenses for erecting building etc for the purpose but if the income is insufficient for that purpose the Trustee may use such portion of the corpus of the Trust fund as may be necessary.
- g) To appoint constituted attorney or agents and delegate to such attorneys of agents all or any of the powers vested on them under these presents and from time to time remove such attorneys or agents and to appoint other or others in his of their place.
- h) To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
- i) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- j) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, society, association, or institution with similar objects.
- k) To establish, promote, manage, organize, or maintain or assist in establishing, promoting, managing, organizing or maintaining any branch of the trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust and to promote or vary on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust.
- l) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any exiting institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.

4. That the following shall be the type of Trustees:

6. **POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF THE MANAGING TRUSTEE.**

The managing Trustees shall function Subject to the guidance supervision and control of the Board of Trustees. The powers of Board of Trustees may be delegated to the Managing Trustees in the Meeting of Board of Trustees to discharge the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. He is the chief administrator of the trust and shall manage the day- to- day affairs of the Trust.
- b. He is responsible for proper maintenance of record and registers of the trust and is the custodian of all documents, registers and the properties belonging to the trust.
- c. He has to prepare annual budget and place the same before the annual Trust board meeting for the purpose of the approval of the trust as is considered prudent and necessary. He can receive application scrutinize and allow monetary assistance to deserving candidates, to prosecute higher studies.
- d. He can raise funds by lawful means and accepts donations from the public as well as other donors by giving proper receipts from the Trusts.
- e. He can acquire properties for and on behalf of the trust and can dispose of the properties on behalf of the trust as and when felt necessary.
- f. He can appoints persons in different post for the trust on suitable salary as is considered proper and can also remove such

- g. He can do all such acts, deeds and things for and on behalf of the trust in the interest of the trust as is deemed necessary. All act done in good faith by the managing trustees in the interest of the trust can not be challenged either by the remaining trustees or by the beneficiaries or for that matter by the donors.
- h. The managing Trustees shall render voluntary service without accepting any remuneration towards the services render by him. However, he shall be entitled to all actual expenses while rendering services for the Trust. The expenses incurred by the managing trustee while rendering services for the trust shall not meet any prior approval from the remaining board of trustees.
- i. The managing trustee shall be honest, faithful and sincere to carry out the objects of the trust.
7. The number of the trustee shall not be less than 4 and more than 9.
8. The founder trustee for the timing will be liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above for such period or, on such terms as to retirement and reappointment, as the trustees for the time being considered proper.
9. BANK ACCOUNT:-
The funds of the trust shall be kept in a bank to be opened by the trust in any of the nationalised bank. The same shall be operated by the managing trustee jointly with another trustee to be elected from amongst the remaining board of trustees.
10. AUDIT:-
The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a qualified chartered accountant and the report of the auditor shall be placed in annual meeting of the board of trustees for their information and necessary action.
11. LEGAL ADVICE:-
The Trust shall appoint an advocate on retainer basis to render legal advice to the trust from time to time.
12. RETIREMENT OF A TRUSTEE:-
In case a Trustee desires to retire from the Trusteeship, he can do so by giving three months notice in writing. On expiry of the period or death, vacancy so created may be filled by nominating another person by remaining trustees.

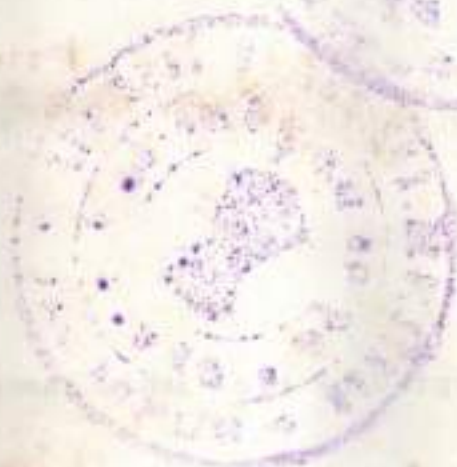
